## **DIRECTIONS TO HASSANI, FOCAS & FIFER, P.A.**

### **From the Interstate 695– the Baltimore Beltway, coming from the EAST:**

Take Exit 26, MD-45 N/York Road.

Continue north on York Road for about ½ a mile.

Make a RIGHT at the second traffic light onto E. Seminary Avenue.

Make a RIGHT into the THIRD ENTRANCE into the Galleria Shopping Center immediately after the black “1447 York Road sign” with an arrow pointing to the right.

GALLERIA TOWERS will be on the right just past the small traffic circle.

### **From the Interstate 695– the Baltimore Beltway, coming from the WEST:**

Take Exit 26B, MD-45 N/York Road.

Continue north on York Road for about ¾ of a mile.

Make a RIGHT at the second traffic light onto E. Seminary Avenue.

Make a RIGHT into the THIRD ENTRANCE into the Galleria Shopping Center immediately after the black “1447 York Road sign” with an arrow pointing to the right.

GALLERIA TOWERS will be on the right just past the small traffic circle.

### **From the NORTH (Cockeysville, Hunt Valley, etc.):**

Take York Road south (from Timonium or Padonia Roads).

Make a LEFT onto E. Seminary Avenue.

Make a RIGHT into the THIRD ENTRANCE into the Galleria Shopping Center immediately after the black “1447 York Road sign” with an arrow pointing to the right.

GALLERIA TOWERS will be on the right just past the small traffic circle.

### **PARKING FOR CLIENTS**

There is plenty of free parking in the lots surrounding the Galleria Towers and Shopping Center.

You may enter the building either from the 1st floor on the east side of the building or through the main lobby on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor facing the main parking lot for the shopping center. There are “First Floor Lobby” signs throughout the parking lot, including the traffic circle, to point you in the right direction.

We are on the 8<sup>th</sup> floor in Suite 800, immediately to the right after exiting the elevators.
